### **DIVISION IV**

### REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

### 10-1 43-44000 SERIES WIPER MOTOR (NON-DEPRESSED)

- 1. Disconnect battery.
- 2. Remove cowl screen.
- 3. Loosen the two (2) nuts on the adjustable motor drivelink at the crank arm and slip drivelink off. See Figure 10-1.
- 4. Remove electrical connectors from washer motor and pump.
- 5. Disconnect washer pump hoses.
- 6. Remove three (3) bolts securing motor to cowl and carefully lift motor away from cowl.
- 7. To reinstall motor, reverse the above removal procedure.

### 10-2 43-44000 SERIES WIPER MOTOR (DEPRESSED PARK)

- 1. Disconnect battery.
- 2. Remove hoses from washer nozzles.
- 3. Remove rubber weatherstrip and cowl screen.
- 4. Use a 3/8" socket and loosen the two (2) nuts on the adjustable motor drivelink at the crank arm and slip off.
- 5. Disconnect washer hoses and electrical connectors from pump and motor.
- 6. Remove three (3) wiper motor to cowl retaining screws, using a 5/16" socket.
- 7. To reinstall wiper motor, reverse the removal procedure.

#### 10-3 45-46-48-49000 WIPER MOTOR

- 1. Disconnect battery.
- 2. Remove cowl screen.
- 3. Using a 3/8" socket, loosen two (2) nuts on the wiper transmission drivelink to wiper motor cranking arm and slip drivelink off of cranking arm.
- 4. Disconnect washer pump hoses and two (2) electrical connectors, one from washer pump and one from wiper motor.

- 5. Using a 5/16" socket, remove three (3) screws holding motor to cowl.
- 6. To reinstall, reverse removal procedure.

### 10-4 WASHER PUMP REMOVAL (ALL DEPRESSED PARK SYSTEMS)

**NOTE**: This operation can be done with washer motor on or off the car.

- 1. Remove washer pump hoses.
- 2. Disconnect electrical connector at pump.
- 3. Snap off plastic shield.
- 4. Remove three (3) screws securing pump to motor and lift pump off of motor.
- 5. To install washer pump, reverse removal procedure. Rotate washer pump drive cam so that hole in cam and hole in washer pump mounting plate are aligned. Insert a length of 1/8" rod through pump mounting plate and cam to maintain alignment while installing pump on wiper motor.

#### 10-5 43-44000 SERIES WIPER TRANSMISSION

- 1. Disconnect washer hose from washer nozzles.
- 2. Remove rubber weatherstrip from front of cowl screen and five (5) snap clips from the rear of the screen; then remove the cowl screen.
- 3. Use a 3/8" socket and loosen the two (2) nuts on the drivelink socket bearing at the crank arm and slip drivelink link off of the crank arm. See Figure 10-1.
- 4. Remove both wiper arm and blade assemblies.
- 5. Remove two (2) screws from the right and left transmission pilot shaft with a 5/16" socket. The third screw on the left side takes a 7/16" socket and should be removed last.
- 6. With the transmission assembly laying loose, rotate it towards front of car and remove through the access hole in right side of cowl.
- 7. To reinstall transmission, reverse the removal procedure.

#### 10-6 45-46-48-49000 SERIES WIPER TRANSMISSION

- 1. Remove cowl screen.
- 2. Remove both wiper blade assemblies.
- 3. Loosen the two (2) drivelink to crank arm adjusting nuts and slip drivelink off crank arm.


- 4. Remove the two (2) wiper blades and wiper arm assemblies.
- 5. Remove six (6) bolt securing wiper transmissions to
- cowl, three on each side at the serrated head of output shaft.
- 6. To reinstall transmission assembly, reverse removal procedure.
